

News and Notes from Mrs. Newman's Class For the week of April 29th

Our Journeys story this week is titled, **Two of Everything**. This folktale from China is about a farmer who finds an unusual brass pot that doubles everything put inside it. But is that always a good thing? In the traditional tale of **Stone Soup**, we will read about a clever man who figures out how to make soup from a stone. With both good stories, we'll explore the question "What good things happen when people work together?" Our spelling pattern will revolve around words with long vowels and vowel diphthongs.

In math we will continue working with our geometry unit as we explore a variety of shapes. We will be describing and identifying the attributes of 2-dimensional shapes. We will build and compare various polygons as we look at triangles, pentagons, and hexagons. We will also draw quadrilaterals with given attributes.

As we continue our Animal and Plant Dependence unit, we will focus on how pollination is an important part of the life cycle of a plant. We will read and learn about the different kinds of plant pollinators. Your child will be observing and watching the life cycle of one of these plant pollinators daily in our classroom. How exciting! Be sure to ask them about it. ©
